Morning chores were collecting cow dung for the fire and to stucco their houses in an effort to keep the mosquitoes away. They were both taken under the wing of a loving family in Nambucca Heads NSW, who hold them up in prayer sending them HOPE and encouraging them through life. Thanks to this sponsoring family, they will have a better chance on life, hopefully, like children here in Australia have. Guddi and Rajesh love their sponsors **because in their Robin's Nest they get "really nice parents, education, a bed, and good food!"**
