We're looking forward to visiting the India orphanage and Baragaon late December and if you'd like us to take gifts, please pass them to us by Monday 12 December.

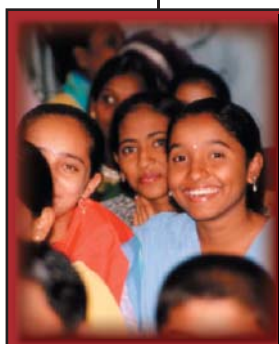
### Robin & Grahame

*Robin's Nest Childrens Homes provide hope and a home with loving Christian parents for orphaned, abandoned, mal-treated, poverty and HIV/Aids affected children in Webuye, Kenya (est. 2004) and Agra, India (est. 2005). Each child is taught to develop employment skills and attend higher education if they wish, to break the poverty cycle in their life.*

## Robin's Nest India

The official opening of RN India occurred on 11 September and was supported by more than 50 pastors and leaders from Agra.

We started a Wish List in August to enable its establishment and are delighted to report that your giving since then means that EVERY item off the list has been bought!



A little goes a long way in Agra, where more than 50% of children live below the poverty line.

You've helped to provide the children with uniforms, beds, chairs, desks, fans and more.

### Current Needs

- ♥ Due to the regularity of blackouts in India - up to 5 hours at a time - the home is in need of an inverter which will give up to 4 hours back-up for lights and fans. Cost: AU\$270.
- ♥ Harry has purchased some land to build a bigger children's home, however they need AU\$1,400 to register it with the government before building can proceed.
