| December 6 th | Count the blankets on the beds and put in 2 cents for each. |

| December 8 th | Put in 3 cents for every water tap. |
| December 9 th | Put in 2 cents for each piece of fruit in your fridge. |
| December 10 th | Put in 25 cents for each car your family owns. |
| December 11 th | Put in 5 cents for each glass of milk you drank today. |
| December 12 th | How many windows are there in your house? Put in 2 cents for each one. |
| December 13 th | How many eggs are there in your fridge? 1 cent each. |
| December 14 th | 25 cents for 10 stuffed animals and 50 cents for more than 10. |
| December 15 th | 3 cents for every year you have lived. |
| December 16 th | 2 cents for each pair of socks you own. |
| December 17 th | 2 cents for each time you used water today. |
| December 18 th | 10 cents for each TV. |
| December 19 th | 10 cents for each wastebasket. |
| December 20 th | 1 cent per step in your home. |
| December 21 st | 5 cents for each box of cereal. |
| December 22 nd | 25 cents per pet. |
| December 23 rd | 10 cents if you have outdoor Christmas lights. |
| December 24 rd | 2 cents for each person you will give a Christmas present to. |
| December 25 th | 2 cents per each light bulb on your tree. |
| December 26 th | 2 cents for each Christmas card you received. |
| December 27 th | 25 cents if you need to take any presents back to exchange. |
| December 28 th | 25 cents if you own less than 10 books and 50 cents if you own more than 10 books. |
| December 29 th | 5 cents for each pair of shoes you own. |
| December 30 th | 25 cents if you own a bicycle. |
| December 31 st | 3 cents for each movie you've seen in the last month. |
